Medical Care Needs

In Lee County, Alabama, there are an estimated 14,739 persons under the age of 65 without health insurance. Persons without coverage can have serious health consequences because they receive less preventative care and delayed care can result in more serious illness or health problems.

At Mercy Medical Ministry, we provide compassionate healthcare and prescription assistance to uninsured patients. In 2022 through the efforts of 21 different health care providers and 7 staff members, patients received excellent, affordable healthcare. All patients are treated with gentleness and respect regardless of socioeconomic status, race, nationality or religious affiliation.

Patient Spotlight

Joseph* first came to Mercy Medical Ministry in the fall of 2023. A family friend told him about the clinic: the knowledgeable healthcare providers, the excellent service and the affordable care. "It's luxury services without the expensiveness of healthcare," he stated.

Having been recently diagnosed with Type 2 Diabetes, Joseph was unsure of the future of his physical health, but he knew he needed to make some lifestyle changes and seek professional advice. At his first visit, he was impressed that the providers spent time talking with him about adjustments he could make to his diet and lifestyle to help manage his diabetes. While the medical advice he received was beneficial, he was most impacted by the Christian atmosphere of the clinic.

"As soon as you walk in the door, you feel the change of environment: the friendship and the attentiveness of people. They talk to you. They pray for you. Prayers that help your life," said Joseph.

Gospel-Centered Venue

At Mercy Medical Ministry, we provide a venue for people of faith to serve others in our community. In 2022, volunteers contributed over 13,000 hours of service. Volunteers assisted in the front office, aided in patient care and triage, and provided spiritual encouragement for patients and their families. Because Mercy Medical sees the importance of a patient's overall wellbeing, we seek to connect patients and their families to area churches and local resources. Our spiritual encourager volunteers have the opportunity to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with patients and families, provide them with Christian literature and Bibles, and pray for them.

The joy of serving is not only a blessing to others, but also to her own spiritual life. "I have the

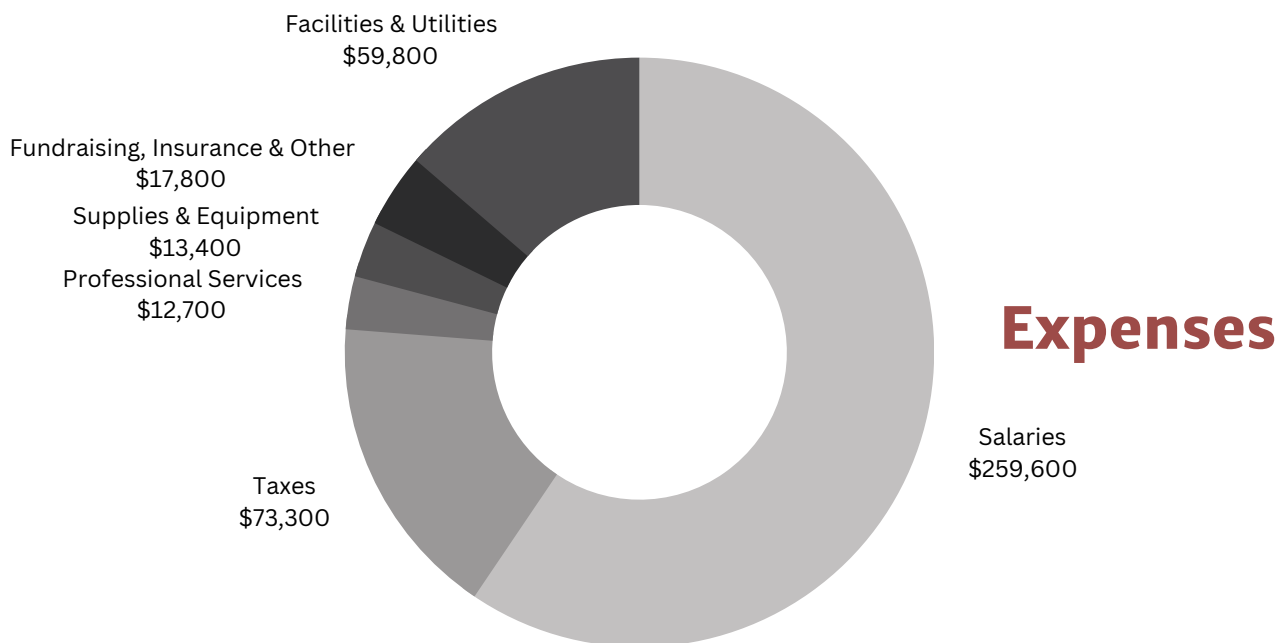
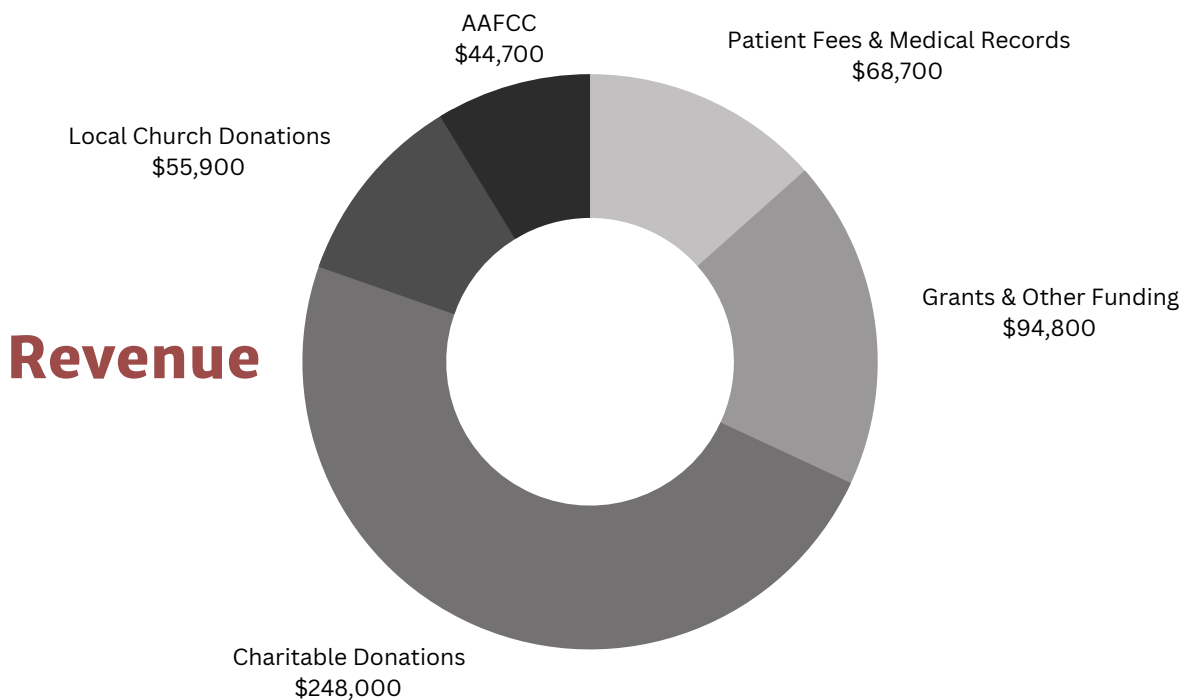

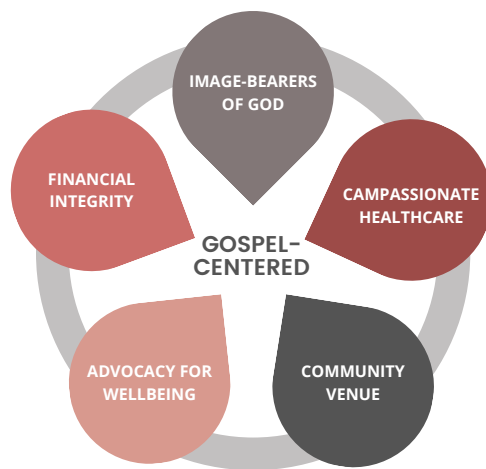
